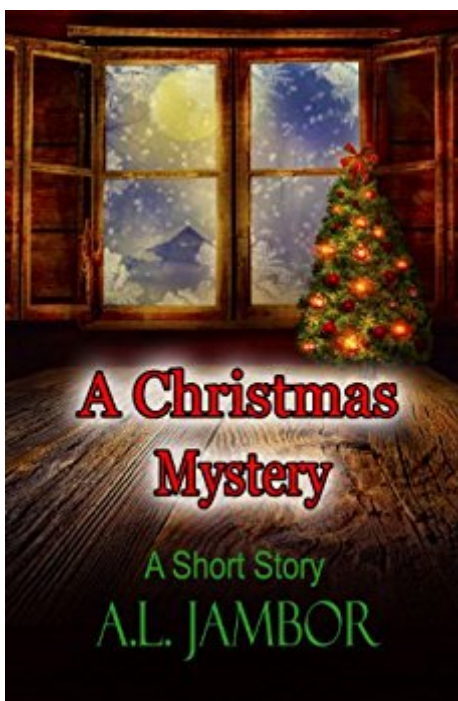

I love a story well written and entertaining. This was both. And it was such a fun read on Christmas eve.

This is a short story which seems to be written for kids in the 7-13 year range. Sort of a combination of Halloween and Christmas, this tale involves the plight of a young family struggling to make ends meet and the helpful spirit which enables them to succeed. I'm a little torn here as this "Christmas mystery" involves not only a corrupt police chief but spousal abuse, bootlegging, and not one but two murders. Add that littany of crimes to the other situations which befall this family and you have a fairly depressing read. It's kind of a shame that the author went this route with a Christmas story, but hey, how many kids got video games and are now sitting in front of the TV or computer happily blowing apart virtual humans by the thousands?
