

This fictional story of a medical student's trials and tribulations, both getting through medical school and struggling to keep his personal life afloat at the same time, is a bawdy, hyperbolic romp. Written by a practicing physician, one has to wonder at the kernel of truth that spawned these stories; since they are taken to their comedic extreme, some are likely to leave the reader wondering and his head spinning. This is not a "touchy-feely" medical memoir, but rather an amped up, sometimes sarcastic and often hilarious wild ride through medical training. It should provide fun-filled distraction from studies for those currently going through medical school and residency, and a window into the many challenges including the serious and the absurd that doctors-in-training face on all fronts for other readers.

Not since "House of God" has there been a novel that so eloquently captures life in medical education in the U.S. In this book, the author goes one step further and delves into the struggles of also maintaining a life outside of medical school. The work is beautifully written, with vivid descriptions of New York City, medical training and the grueling process of surviving med school. In addition, the author uses brilliant humor and elicits some truly laugh-out-loud moments! This is a must-read for anyone in the medical profession, but also quite enjoyable for someone who just wants to hear how it all happens. You will not be disappointed!
